II. Facilities and other amenities at the Polytechnics:

- a. Ideally located and conducive environment for study with qualified faculty and support staff as per AICTE, COA norms and regulations.
- b. All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi and Council of Architecture (COA) New Delhi approved Institutions respectively.
- c. Quality Technical Education through hand on practical classes, entrepreneurship and Industrial trainings. 24 hours power backup facility for academics' block.
- d. Civil Engineering, Electrical & Electronics Engineering & Mechanical Engineering program at KPA and Civil Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering program at GPK has been accredited by the National Board of Accreditation (NBA). The other Polytechnics are also pursuing for NBA accreditation.
- e. State of the Art Laboratories with smart classrooms and internet facilities with smart classroom.
- f. Hostels and Bus services available.
- g. Scholarship: State as well as Central Scheme, Pragati Sakshan (Girl students).
- h. Conduct Co-curricular activities.
- i. Online and Offline admission and classes.
- j. Industrial visit/Training/Internship as per NEP2020
- k. Placement of Polytechnic passed out students in various State Government, Central Government and Private sectors etc. and in pipeline with reputed Industries for pool campus Interviews.
- 1. Provision to pursue higher studies after Diploma.

III. Curriculum:

New curriculum based on NEP2020 to be introduced from session 2025-26 onwards.

IV. Admission to Diploma courses in Government Polytechnics in Nagaland for the academic session 2025-26

The Candidate must have passed HSLC examination with Mathematics and Science for Engineering (Civil Engineering, Electrical & Electronics Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Automobile Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engineering), for Architecture Assistantship & Interior Design passed HSLC/10+ with Maths, Science and aggregate of 55% or HSSLC/12+(Science) with Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics (PCM) and aggregate of 50% and for Fashion Technology (FT) a candidate must have passed HSLC. The candidates who have appeared HSLC/HSSLC during 2025 are also eligible to applied for the course provisionally subject to fulfillment of terms and condition.

V. Last date of Form submission along with necessary documents to the undersigned office on or before 29th March, 2025

VI. Announcement of Results:

Provisional Merit list will be declared on within 10 working days of HSLC/HSSLC result 2025 and will be available on Department Website:(https://dte.nagaland.gov.in) and Notice Board of Directorate of Technical Education and Polytechnics.

VII.Reservation Policy:

- a. 15% reservation shall be made for Backward Tribes on the basis of One Tribe One Seat as per merit.
- b. 10% of the total intake in all courses shall be reserved for Female Candidates.
- c. 5% special reservation shall be made for Differently able/Physically Handicapped students. The selection of students shall be made as per disability conditions prescribed by Medical Council of India/State in its notification in the regard.
- d. Out of the remaining seats, 90% of seats will be reserved for ST Indigenous of Nagaland and 10% of seats will be reserved for General Category against the following Courses: (Electrical & Electronics Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Automobile Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engineering, Architecture Assistantship, Interior Design and Fashion Technology) except Civil Engineering.
- e. In the event, there are no takers from the above 1) 2) 3) & 4) categories, then the seats shall be de-reserved to ST Naga candidates belonging to the State of Nagaland.

VIII. Procedure of Selection:-

- 1. Selection of Candidates is done on the basis of the merit from the HSLC/HSSLC marks and also incorporating reservation policies of the State.
- 2. In case of tie in the merit list a candidate be ranked higher on the basis of marks scored in Maths, Science, English of HSLC/HSSLC and age for Engineering/Architecture Assistantship/Interior Design category. In case of tie in Fashion Technology the merit list a candidate be ranked higher on the basis of marks scored in English, General Knowledge, Maths and Science of HSLC and age.
- 3. Selection of candidate to a Diploma Program will be done based on HSLC/HSSLC merit list and availability of seat in the Diploma Program(s) of his/her stated preference (s).
- 3. Naga Indigenous inhabitants of the State shall be accorded first preference for selection. Thereafter, preference shall be accorded to children of non-Naga Indigenous inhabitant of the State, children of Non-Naga State Govt. Employees, Central Govt./Agency Employees serving in the State as per merit of HSLC/HSSLC marks.
- 4. In event of any discrepancy in merit list, selection, nomination, the selection committee shall decide the course of action and shall recommended to authority for implementation.
